## Bead Incentive Program

Blue & Purple beads will be earned at the Den meetings

- 1 bead for Scout book
- 1 bead for Class A uniform
- 1 bead for attending Den meeting
- 1 bead for wearing Class A uniform to another function

A Scout may have beads taken away during a meeting for inappropriate behavior.

Blue & Purple beads may be traded at Wampum Store for the following items:

10 beads = 1 Bone Whistle

15 beads – or – 1 Bone Whistle and 5 beads = 1 Bear Claw

20 beads – or - 1 Bone Whistle and 10 beads = 1 Eagle Claw

Other colored beads will be earned for other activities. These beads cannot be traded for any other items.

Given at the Wampum Store and serves as an indication of the boy's activities.

- 1 Yellow for attending Pack Meeting
- 1 Green for attending a District Event
- 1 Red for attending a Council Event
- 1 Metallic for money raising event or fundraiser
- 1 Silver for a Good Turn
- 1 Wooden for Pinewood Derby

All District and Council attendance is up to the Den Leaders to keep and turn in to the Wampum Store for the beads. The Silver beads can be given by the Leaders at the time of a Good Turn or Good Deed.

The Wampum Store will have a uniform inspection four random times a year (based on BSA guidelines).
